Paul's Transformation : Paul's Christ 1 Critical Revelation (Galatians 1:16)

1.1 What was Paul's objection to the possibility of Jesus being the Messiah/Christ? Deuteronomy 21:22-23 and Galatians 3:13

1.2 Consider the accounts (Galatians 1: 11-24, Acts 9, Acts 26) of Paul's encounter with God on his way to Damascus to zealously persecute and to extinguish the belief in the resurrection of Jesus, and identify the relationship between that encounter and the following major tenets of Paul's theology.

The Trinity as an ultimate revelation of the nature and being of God

The Church as the Body of Christ

σῶμα	Immortal, imperishable body (Jesus, sacramental bread, resurrection body, church)
σὰρξ	sinful, perishable body/flesh

The identification of God with suffering

Acts 9:16: "I myself will show him how much he must suffer for the sake of my name."

The non-violent nature of God

Rom 14:17 the Kingdom of God is ... righteousness, peace and joy.

Rom 8:39 nothing in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus

Rom 15:5, 6 God of steadfastness and encouragement grant you to live in harmony with one another in accordance with Christ Jesus

Rom 8:34 It is Christ Jesus who died. Yes. who was raised, who is the righteousness of God.

Rom 8:35-39 Who will separate us from Christ? Will hardship, distress, persecution, famine, nakedness, peril, sword? No in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.

Rom 13:10 love is the fulfilment of God's law

Grace transcending Law

Rom 3: 21- 26 ...since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

Rom 8:1-3 Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death. For God has done what the law, weakened by flesh, was powerless to do: by sending his own Son ...

(Romans 5:18-21) Therefore just as one man's act trespass led to condemnation for all, so one man's act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all ... so grace might also exercise dominion through justification leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

(Galatians 5:16) Live by the Spirit ... the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. (Gal 5:23,23)
