SEEDS OF HOPE

Despite stories of seeds taken from ancient Egyptian tombs growing after thousands of years the only solid evidence of ancient seeds growing is of several date palm seeds found in a Masada fortress beside the Dead Sea in Israel in the 1960's.

Of these, three were planted and astonishingly one actually grew. The others were found to date to the time of Christ making them 2000 years old. It is hard to imagine an embryo still having a food supply and still being sufficiently active after all this time. However, if you are into growing heirloom seeds, I feel this one takes the prize. Over the next couple of weeks our readings explore the theme of the Kingdom of God. How do we explain it?

Jesus said the Kingdom of God is like seeds a "sower" was broadcasting in a field and they grew to produce grain. Further to this parable is another; the Kingdom of God is like a mustard seed which when planted grows to become a healthy bush and so becomes a haven for the birds. Now I am told that a seed consists of three main parts: the seed casing, the endosperm which is the food supply and the embryo. If it was a coconut, we can visualise these three parts fairly clearly.

However, what is it about the Kingdom seeds? What are they? What does the embryo look like? How are they sown? How do they actually grow? What do they become?

I believe all these questions can be answered as we reflect on our own lives.
