I have been reading an article about cuttlefish and how in the last couple of decades science has become aware of a bay just south of Whyalla where millions migrate between May and August for the yearly mating season. It's the only known migration of its kind in the world.

The giant male cuttlefish grows to about a metre in length which certainly outdoes the shell we find on the beach.
