Rev John Flynn's vision was to spread across the Inland a 'Mantle of Safety', to the isolated people of outback Australia. All these years later, it is sobering to realise that so many of the issues Flynn contended within 1912 are still very much part of life in rural and remote areas of Australia.

Through the network of Bush Chaplains, the work of Outback Links volunteers and the Uniting Church in Australia, Frontier Services, actively supports and sustains this treasure that lies at the heart of our nation, and continue to travel to the furthest fence to support those in need.

The statistics around mental health for farming families are alarming. Suicide rates are twice as likely in rural & remote areas in Australia, however a study in Qld revealing that there is a 5-times more likely chance to commit suicide in these areas of remote QLD.

For Frontier Services, the calls have increased a lot. Also, it's the level of people struggling with mental health stress. The types of calls for help and assistance are shifting, so Frontier Services are having to deal with people at this new crisis level, but there are those early indicators where families are deteriorating and the children are displaying levels of stress as well. Drought... bushfires COVID-19 plagues of vermin and insects ... then there will be widespread flooding! This list is inexhaustible for our farming communities. Sometimes our bush chaplains are the only people there to be a contact, a friend to those living a life of rural isolation.
