**From the desk of the minister:** **Welcome to the First Psalm**  
Preacher Dr. Billy Graham said that in our own day enthusiasm for the psalms has not diminished. He is so convinced about their benefits that he encourages all the listeners to read the psalms regularly. If we read 5 psalms a day, we can get through the entire collection in a month. For many churches around the world the psalms, either sung or read, are a vital aspect of their corporate worship. This is a tradition that I want us to do in our church here in Nambour, that we read responsively the psalm every Sunday. Psalm 1 is the doorway to the psalms. Alan Palmer said, "The book of psalms has been compared to a mansion with 150 rooms. In each room we can make new discoveries about God and about ourselves. Psalm 1 is the doorway through which we enter this large and exciting building. The first psalm is not only the entry point to the book, it also sets the style for what follows. All that follows should be read in the light of Psalm 1. For here we have set before us God's perception of the true state of every man and woman. The Creator speaks in clear and uncomplicated terms to his creatures. There are only two options for us while living here on earth. Either we are for God or we are against him.

### TOMORROW - St Valentines Day

The first recorded association of Valentine's Day with romantic love is believed to be in the *Parliament of Fowls* (1382) by Chaucer, a dream vision portraying a parliament for birds to choose their mates.

Honouring the first anniversary of the engagement of fifteen-year-old King Richard II of England to fifteen-year-old Anne of Bohemia, Chaucer wrote:

**"For this was on Saint Valentine's Day  
When every bird comes there to choose his match  
Of every kind that men may think of  
And that so huge a noise they began to make  
That earth and air and tree and every lake  
Was so full, that not easily was there space  
For me to stand—so full was all the place."**

Readers have uncritically assumed that Chaucer was referring to February 14 as Valentine's Day.
