The Day of Pentecost

Collect: Lord God, you spoke with power when you made the world. You spoke with clarity when the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us. You carved out a new people when your Spirit descended in our midst at Pentecost. We call to mind today your transforming power. Sweep us away despite our native caution. Create again your people, driven by your Spirit. Amen.

From the desk of the minister Rev Maile Molitika: The Spirit of Unity

Luke's narrative begins with the disciples coming together in one place. Unity is always the beginning of something amazing and this is the beginning of an onward advance of the church in the power of the Holy Spirit. **They were all in one place: they were together in body, and they were together in Spirit.** "With one accord" is a favourite phrase with St. Luke; it is used TEN times in Acts. Disunity hinders the outpouring of the Spirit, whether it is the disunity of outward separation, or the disunity of inner alienation.

Wind and fire are powerful symbols of the mission the Holy Spirit accomplishes in each Christian soul.

We cannot live without air. At the creation God breathed into man's nostrils the breath of life: and man became a living soul. The life-giving spirit of God therefore came to these first disciples as the breath of God and was a source of new spiritual life in them. After the Holy Spirit descended on them, they were empowered to go out into the world to tell the good news of the Lord. Peter was able to attract 3000 people into Christ simply because of the power of the Holy Spirit. Without the Holy Spirit, our evangelism will be in vain. We won't be able to do things in our own selfish ways. The tower of babel is the reverse of the story of the Pentecost. People in their pride come together to build a tower to reach God. They didn't need God, because they had everything. No wonder God disrupted the language so that they could not communicate to each other.

The Pentecost Story is the coming of the Holy Spirit upon a people who are ready in their oneness to preach the word, and then sending them with a burning enthusiasm for God's service. The story of Pentecost is our story too!
