Faith heroes enable us to see God (Hebrews 11).

Seeing is believing: You need to see something before you can accept that it really exists or occurs. We are wired as rational human beings. We need to see something before we believe it.

And this is true of God: seeing is believing!

Creation helps us. When we see beautiful mountains, an amazing whale, sparkling stars, we believe there is a creator.

But what if we cannot see God? What about the times when God seems to hide himself in a cloud?

Or we are in such darkness we cannot see.

Persons dying from cancer, persons who have lost homes in floods or fires, persons caught up in the vicious cycle of domestic violence find it difficult to see God.

In such times faith heroes help us to see God, reveal God to us, show us that God is real. This is what the ancient heroes did - like Noah, Enoch and Abraham.

And this is what we modern faith heroes need to do you.

To enable one another and others to see God.

The letter Hebrews shows us ways to guide us: (1) to see and fix our eyes on Jesus, on the heavenly (read Heb 2:8-9; 3:1; 11:16; 12:2-3).

(2) to recognise we are merely aliens and strangers on earth – travellers without worldly citizenship, living in tents (Heb 11:8-10, 13).

Yeah, you and I need to be faith heroes.
