#### COVID-19 update for Churches - Nov 2022

The Qld Government announced that Qld has entered the fourth COVID wave. Public health direction has revoked isolation and quarantine periods for persons contracting COVID, meaning a diagnosed person no longer needs to remain at home whilst positive. The potential for the virus to circulate in our community has increased substantially. We request that folk avoid face-to-face worship and other activities whilst unwell. Hand hygiene and physical distancing to the extent possible and cleaning continue to be essential control measures preventing the spread of the virus. Masks are recommended in healthcare settings, indoors, if you can't physically distance, if you are older or medically at risk, on public transport, if you are around people who are vulnerable to COVID-19 - **we love each other, we care for one another, we keep each other safe.**
