### **SUNDAY 25th June 2023**

A teacher attempts to educate in a particular way, teaching a truth as the teacher understands it. A disciple's single, overriding purpose is to emulate his teacher. If we listen to Jesus' teachings, the absolute best we can do for ourselves is to be Christlike, disciples of Jesus. In the reading in Matthew 10:26-31 today, Jesus is explaining one of the passages of Our Good News Bible;

#### **Whom To Fear**

Through our Christian understanding there is no one to fear (but God). Should we fear the unknown? The unknown does not exist until there is a sense of realisation of its existence. We should have no fear of the dark for when the light comes on, we see the table, the chairs in our room just as when the light went off. The most amazing discovery when Jesus found us and came into our lives is that we don't have to be afraid anymore, that Jesus gives us a power that overcomes fear. Many people have attested to this one feature of their transformation into a Christian life.

We don't have to be afraid!

Say a small prayer to yourself at times of these stresses;

This actually works, as the true Spirit of Jesus arrives and overcomes fear, the warmth of this love washes over us as we are contending with our own demons.
