Collect: O God, whose glory it is always to have mercy: Be gracious to all who have gone astray from your ways, and bring them again with penitent hearts and steadfast faith to embrace and hold fast the unchangeable truth of your Word. Jesus Christ your Son; who with you and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns; one God, for ever and ever, Amen.

From the desk of the minister: **Get Behind Me**

This is one of the well-known words of Jesus to his disciple Peter. Today's gospel is known as the first passion prediction. Jesus told his disciples about his suffering and he will be rejected by the elders, the leading priests and the teachers of religious law. He would be killed, but three days later he would rise from the dead. As he talked about this openly with his disciples, Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. But Jesus turned around, looked at his disciples, and rebuked Peter. **"Get behind me, Satan!"** he said, **"You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns."**

Jesus has spent so much time talking with disciples and demonstrating his truths before them and still they don't get it! He must have been deeply hurt inside from their lack of faith in him. He said to Peter don't try to temp me away from the path to the cross and the resurrection life - I am here for a mission and that mission should be completed according to my direction from my Father.

If we think about this conversation between Jesus and his disciples, how often do we do that with each other? Someone will tell us of a tough journey ahead, maybe even a struggle with health or relates to another person and we feel to give discouragement rather than encouragement.

Jesus has called these people to follow him from the start.

Now in this conflict, Peter somehow wants Jesus to follow him. He is no longer in his right position as a follower, he wants to lead and Jesus would follow him. This is our true humanity, we sometimes see things differently from God's perspective.

Today we are reminded by Jesus – "Get behind Me" don't try to go in front of me, because I am the Leader.
