Collect: Grant, O merciful God, that your church, being gathered together in unity by your Holy Spirit, may show forth your power among all peoples, to the glory of your Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever, Amen.

From the desk of the minister: The Words of Life

So he asked the twelve disciples, "And you, would you also like to leave?" Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom would we go? You have the words that give eternal life. And now we believe and know that you are the Holy One who has come from God."

We have come across in chapter 6 of John's Gospel for 5 weeks now and today is the last reading from John, before we go back to Mark's Gospel. But as I reflect in all the readings from Chapter 6, it is all about the Bread of Life. Jesus had tried his best to explain to his audience about the significance of this Bread. This is the bread that nourishes our soul into eternity.

In our reading today, Jesus is telling the crowd — "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life. But there are some of you who do not believe."

He said to them you must eat my flesh and drink my blood to have spiritual life. Many of these followers rejected this shocking teaching.

But in reality, Jesus' teachings were spiritual and not to be interpreted literally, but these half-hearted people were unwilling to dig deeper to unpack what Jesus was saying. They weren't committed followers. To me, the climax of chapter 6 was the question to the disciples, and Peter answered – "Lord, to whom would we go? You have the words that give eternal life. And now we believe and know that you are the Holy One who has come from God." Peter's answer really showed their allegiance to Christ. There is no one who can offer life eternal but Christ alone!

How do you react when you encounter a hard teaching in the Bible? Are you quick to dig deeper, comparing it with other scriptures on the subject, or do you reject it like these shallow followers of Christ? **Today, we witness together with the disciples – The Words of Life come from Jesus the Son of God.**
