- ¹ How lovely is your dwelling place, LORD Almighty!
- ² My soul yearns, even faints, for the courts of the LORD; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God.
- ³Even the sparrow has found a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may have her young—a place near your altar, LORD Almighty, my King and my God.
- ⁴Blessed are those who dwell in your house; they are ever praising you.
- ⁵ Blessed are those whose strength is in you, whose hearts are set on pilgrimage.
- ⁶ As they pass through the Valley of Baka, they make it a place of springs; the autumn rains also cover it with pools.
- ⁷ They go from strength to strength, till each appears before God in Zion.
- ⁸ Hear my prayer, LORD God Almighty; listen to me, God of Jacob.
- ⁹Look on our shield, O God; look with favour on your anointed one.

Word: John 6.56-69

- ⁵⁶ Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in them. ⁵⁷ Just as the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me. ⁵⁸ This is the bread that came down from heaven. Your ancestors ate manna and died, but whoever feeds on this bread will live forever."
- ⁵⁹ He said this while teaching in the synagogue in Capernaum.

Many Disciples Desert Jesus

⁶⁰ On hearing it, many of his disciples said, "This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?" ⁶¹ Aware that his disciples were grumbling about this, Jesus said to them, "Does this offend you? ⁶² Then what if you see the Son of Man ascend to where he was before! ⁶³ The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you—they are full of the Spirit and life. ⁶⁴ Yet there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus had known from the beginning which of them did not believe and who would betray him. ⁶⁵ He went on to say, "This is why I told you that no one can come to me unless the Father has enabled them."

- ⁶⁷ "You do not want to leave too, do you?" Jesus asked the Twelve.
- ⁶⁸ Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. ⁶⁹ We have come to believe and to know that you are the Holy One of God."

COMMENTARY What intrigues people who don't have any concept about Christianity is its absurdness. It was either the biggest joke or it had to be true. I think that the absurdness of Christianity, (which we may often take for granted) is part of what makes the WORD hard. Jesus is bread! Jesus is bread that came down from heaven! We are to chew on his flesh to have life! Upon hearing such statements for the first time, we might have exclaimed, "Good God, what kind of lunatic is this man!

Q 2 Many people follow Jesus because of what they think they can get out of it, yet often their commitment is luke-warm. How can we have a more genuine faith?

Q 3 People love excuses. We have thousands as to why we can't make church on a Sunday. How important do you think it is to nourish your faith. How do we keep the flame burning bright in our lives?

Q 4 There are many temptations daily that can take us away from a relationship with Christ. How do we remain strong when we find ourselves backsliding – please discuss
