Collect: Lord, we pray that your grace may always precede and follow us, that we may continually be given to good works; through Jesus Christ our Lord who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

From the desk of the minister: “What is the one thing to give up”
This is a familiar gospel to us, “a man ran up and knelt before him, and asked him, “Good Teacher, what must I do to receive eternal life?” “Why do you call me good?” Jesus asked him. “No one is good except God alone.”

This man told Jesus of all his good works and his obedience to the 10 commandments. Jesus looked straight at him with love and said, “**You need only one thing. Go and sell all you have and give the money to the poor, and you will have riches in heaven; then come and follow me.**” Jesus knows everything about this young man. He is a good rich man and may be favoured by the community, but goodness to him is something to be achieved. Jesus knows that one thing really mattered to him and he cannot be parted from it. His wealth really blocked his way to God and that is why Jesus said to him, “**Go and sell your wealth, give it to the poor and then come and follow me.**” Goodness is a relative term when applied to people. But compared to God, “**there is no one who does good except God.**” The New Testament is filled with admonitions to do good and be good. In Luke 6 Jesus said “**a good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and an evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart.**”

Today, we are reminded from this story about the one thing that blocked this young man from being a true follower of Christ. Jesus does not say that rich people find it impossible to be graced with eternal life. He does say we may find it extremely difficult to loosen ourselves up, to free ourselves from loving our wealth more than loving God.

**What do you lack? What do I lack?
What one thing will we not give up for God’s sake?**
