The Gift of Easter

Last Sunday we came talked about the story of Easter. According to the Gospel of John, Mary Magdalene was the woman who went early to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the entrance. She conveyed the news to Peter and John who ran to the tomb to explore for themselves. One entered the tomb and he saw and believed and they went back to where they were staying. The gospel for this week continues with the disciples said nothing for fear of the Jewish leaders. All of a sudden, Jesus stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord. Again, Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven". This is the gift of Easter – The Holy Spirit has been given to the disciples to continue on the mission of God into the world. John's gospels emphasised that Jesus is God. And we have witnessed from the Easter story that Jesus is God. He rose from the dead after three days to show his disciples that he is God. We often think of Thomas with a bad reputation because of his doubt, but when he saw Jesus he said, "My Lord and my God". Again, Thomas witnessed that this was his Lord and his God. As we continue our journey during Easter season, we are reminded that Jesus breathed the Holy Spirit into the disciples so they would have power to forgive sins and reconcile people. Jesus loves us so much that locked doors or doubt cannot keep grace away.

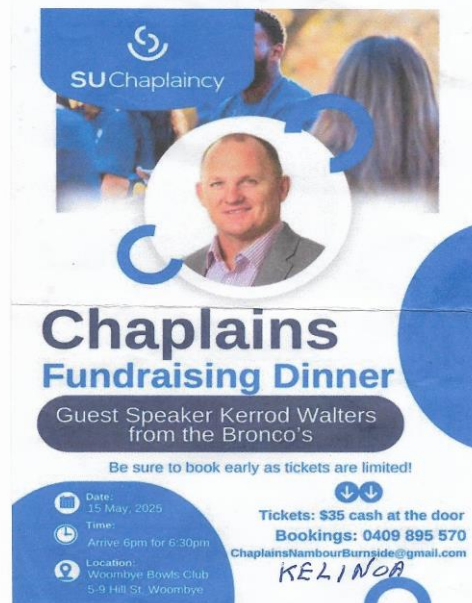
