# From the desk of the Minister: "SING A NEW SONG" The Gospel of Christ is a gospel of freedom

When he saw Jesus, he fell down before him and shouted at the top of his voice, "What have you to do with me, Jesus, Son of Most High God? I beg you, do not torment me" – for Jesus had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man.

They bound him with chains and shackles, but he would break the bonds and be driven by the demon to the wild.
