## 9 NOVEMBER – 22nd SUNDAY OF PENTECOST

*Memorial Service*

**Collect:** We come to you O God because we are the crown of your creation. You made us, gave us life and led us further on the path of truth. But your ways are not our ways and we cannot take human patterns of behaviour and impose them on God. Lord, you call us together to hear your voice, that we might know your grace at work among us. Amen.

**From the desk of the minister:**

### **Celebrate life now, knowing there is life after death**

The context of this gospel reading is the question about the tax. The teachers of the Law and the chief priests are looking for an opportunity to arrest Jesus. So, they ask him a trick question: “Teacher, we know that what you say and teach is right. Tell us, is it against our Law for us to pay taxes to the Roman Emperor, or not?” But Jesus saw through their trick and said to them: “Show me a silver coin. Whose face and name are on it?” “The Emperor’s,” they answered. So, Jesus said: “Well, then, pay the Emperor what belongs to the Emperor, and pay to God what belongs to God.” The same thing happens in today’s gospel. The Sadducees don’t believe the resurrection. They come to Jesus to ask another trick question about a woman who married seven times because Moses allowed it. All the seven husbands died without having children. Last of all, the woman died. Now, on the day when the dead rise to life, whose wife will she be? All seven of them had married her. Jesus answered: “There is no marriage in the next life. Marriage is a gift to be used here on earth.” Jesus wanted to tell them that the life of the age to come differs from this life. Christ was raised by God from the dead and that is enough for us to follow. We are encouraged from our Gospel reading that our God is a Living God and he wants us to enjoy life to the fullest knowing that there is Life after death. Our ultimate future is about a living relationship with a Living God.
