Christ the King

Collect: The days are surely coming, says the Lord, when I will raise up for David a righteous branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. In his days Judah will be saved and Israel will live in safety. And this is the name by which he will be called: "The Lord is our righteousness", Amen.

As we come to the last Sunday of the Christian Calendar, it is appropriate to mark the end of our Christian Calendar, and our journey through-out the year. It is also appropriate to anticipate the beginning of the New Season of Advent, the first season of our Christian Calendar.
