### BAPTISM OF THE LORD

**Collect:** "God shows no partiality" based on ethnicity, gender, or any other natural characteristic", may our Lord God accept us as we are, teaching us through the love of Jesus Christ, and that we may be willing to hear and learn from the Holy Spirit, Amen.

### GOD WAS WITH HIM (and with us)

This week's Lectionary from Acts provides us with the first instance that Peter preaches to a Gentile! Jews tried hard to stay within the boundaries of their religion; today our societies are multicultural and include friendships, marriages, business and sporting situations that are inclusive.

In Peter's day, all the associations were with your own kind and only out of necessity were other denominations or factions allowed in. Peter would have been hesitant at first to go to Cornelius's home to speak about the new Church, Cornelius was a Gentile, one whom Peter should not be associated with. However, we should be able to realise that most of the Church of Jesus Christ were, in fact, Gentiles at this time!

We, as individuals, are blessed with the knowledge that God, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit are the Trinity, three in one. We cannot dictate to others who should or shouldn't believe, God directs all things, Jesus is the life of the Church and the Holy Spirit ministers to us every day.

**Our ears, eyes and mouths should be open to listen, see, and then to speak of the love of Jesus Christ in all our lives.**
