From the desk of the minister: **The only One to trust**

As we continue our journey during epiphany, we are reminded of the one to trust. I am sure we have experienced some kind of failures and troubles in the past because of putting our trust in someone and that person let us down. When you get married you might think you've married your soul mate or the one who completes you. The bible teaches that you should never place someone on that position so that they take God's place. In Psalm 118:8;

"It says – It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to trust in humans."
