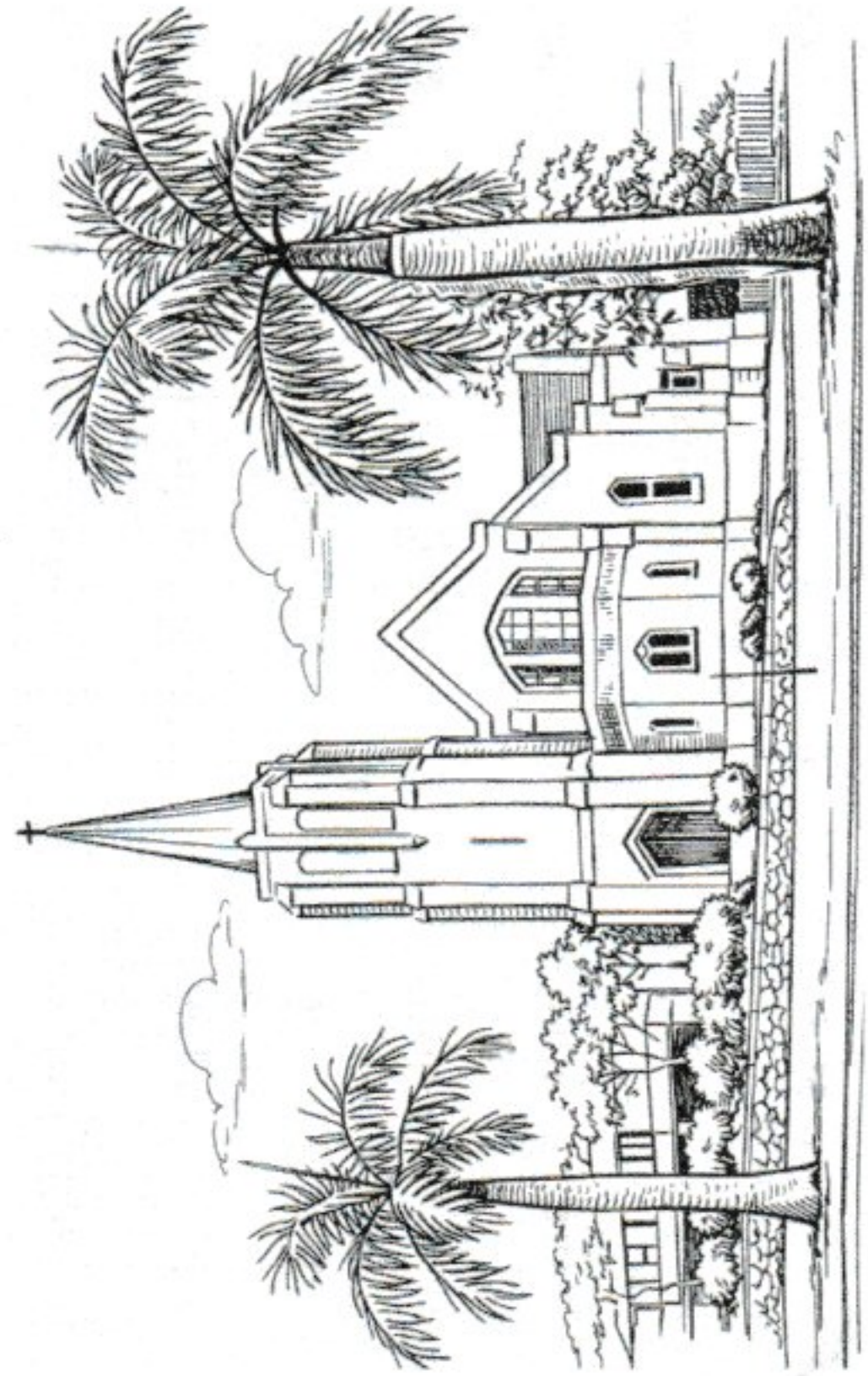

From the Desk of the Minister

Theme: God's glory revealed.

This Sunday is referred to as Transfiguration Sunday. The three Synoptic Gospels all have the story of Jesus' transfiguration in front of three of his disciples. This was six days after Simon Peter's declaration that Jesus was the Christ, the Son of the living God (Matt.16:16).

In Luke's Gospel Jesus went up the mountain to pray and as he was praying he was transfigured (Luke 9:29). The appearance of Moses and Elijah talking with Jesus is astounding. Based on what we read in John's Gospel, the disciples were seeing the glory of Jesus as he was before taking on human form. Then came the voice from heaven declaring Jesus to be his Son. Peter states this experience in his second letter (2 Peter 1:16-18). If people wanted confirmation of the divinity of Jesus surely this would be it.

We read in Exodus of the glory of God being revealed to the Children of Israel on Mount Sinai and again at the dedication of Solomon's Temple to God.

Today God's glory appears to be revealed through people as the Godhead is allowed to dwell in a person and work through their life (John 14:20). We see examples of this from time to time and thus the challenge is to each one of us to let God's glory be seen in our lives.
