## **From the Desk of the Minister**

**Collect:** Almighty and everlasting God, who in the Paschal mystery, has established the new covenant of reconciliation: Grant that all who have been reborn into the fellowship of Christ's Body may show forth in their lives what they profess by their faith; through the same Jesus our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

### **"Christ breathed on them the Peace"**

Last Sunday, we celebrated the great victory of Christ from death in the tomb; today, the first meeting of Christ with his disciples after his resurrection. Christ appears in the Upper Room, no longer limited by the conditions of the flesh. Yet he is the same Lord: the wounds are there in his hands and side.

His first words are a customary greeting, "Peace be with you"; yet how significant they are coming from him at this time!

"Peace on earth" was the proclamation at his birth; "peace and rest of soul" was his offer in his public ministry; "my peace I give unto you" was his legacy to his disciples; peace between God and man through his Atonement; peace between man and man through his grace. To set forward this word of peace among men is now laid upon the Church, and the word is still set forward at the end of every Holy Communion and Funeral – "The Peace of God which surpasses all understanding..." Today, in the Upper Room, he did not rebuke them for running away or for their disbelief. He said to them, "Peace be with you", and then he showed them his hands and his side. Peace for a Christian does not mean absence from conflict. Many persecuted Christians hiding behind locked doors in China and other places, must have found comfort in this Gospel and been glad when they realised that Peace comes from knowledge of the presence of the Lord, and that they can share the strength and victory of his Resurrection. Let us continue to share the Peace of the Lord with ourselves and others.
