Another testing of faith

Last week, we had the feeding of the 5000 and it was a story where Jesus was testing their faith. The disciples want to send the people home, but Jesus said to them, you give them something to eat. Then the miracle followed when they presented the loaves and the fish.

This week's gospel is another testing of faith for the disciples. *Jesus commanded the disciples to get into the boat and getting ahead of him to the other side.* After he had sent the crowds away, Jesus went up the mountain by himself to pray. He might have known that there will be a strong wind come against them, but just like the feeding of the 5000, he tested their faith again. At the very dead of night he came towards them, walking on the water. They saw him walking, thinking it was a ghost. They screamed with terror. But Jesus spoke to them. "Cheer up," he said, it's me! Don't be frightened! Peter said, "If it's really you, Master, give me the word to come to you on the water." "Come along, then," said Jesus. Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus. But when he saw the strong wind he was afraid, and began to sink. This is another testing of faith for this man Peter. When he took off his face from Jesus into the waves and the wind, he started to sink. But the good thing is, Jesus is right there to hold his hand. "Why did you doubt?" They got into the boat, and the wind died down. They worshipped him and said, "You really are God's son!" We are like the disciples in the boat they had seen so much of Jesus' power. They had heard his teaching and prayed his prayer, but still did not have faith. When we had troubles in our journey, do we question our faith in Christ? Hope our faith is rock anchored in Christ, despite the obstacles we encounter in life.
